OSEFx is coming on 26 February: [a free, virtual conference](#) that introduces you to the most pioneering entrepreneurs and the most cutting-edge ventures. Together these will deliver the forum's main objectives: to engage, inform and inspire the vibrant Oxford entrepreneurial community and promote entrepreneurship beyond.

For students at the University of Oxford, exclusive networking sessions with speakers will be scheduled to develop more meaningful relationships between students and speakers. Finally, a pitch competition will showcase ventures from across the Oxford ecosystem with a prize of £10,000 to help the winning venture develop their business further.
